

FDLA Papers to be Published

The Florida Distance Learning Association Journal (FDLA) in partnership with the Distance Learning journal is offering, for the first time, those presenting at the Florida Distance Learning Association conference the opportunity to have a paper about their presentation topic published in a special section of the US Distance Learning Association professional journal, *Distance Learning*. After reviewed and upon acceptance, your paper will be published in both the FDLA journal and the Distance Learning Journal.

Distance Learning is an official publication of the United States Distance Learning Association (USDLA). *Distance Learning* is published for leaders, practitioners, and decision makers in the fields of distance learning, E-learning, telecommunications telehealth, and related areas. It is a professional magazine with information for those who provide instruction to all types of learners, of all ages, using telecommunications technologies of all types. Articles are written by practitioners for practitioners with the intent of providing usable information and ideas for readers.

Publication Guidelines

FDLA presenters are asked to submit their paper by the date of the conference, as specified below. Two publishing options are available:

- Brief articles of approximately 1000 words
- Longer articles of about 3000 words.

If published in *Distance Learning*, authors will receive two copies of the issue with the author's article. Reprints will also be available.

1. Manuscripts should be written in Microsoft Word, saved as a .doc file or docx file, and sent on flash drive or CD.
2. Single-space the entire manuscript. Use 12 point Times New Roman (TNR) font.
3. Laser print two copies of the paper.
4. Margins – 1” on all sides.
5. Include a cover sheet with the paper's title and with the names, affiliations, and addresses of all authors. High-resolution professional photographs of all authors should be included and should have a file size larger than 500kb.
6. Submit the manuscript on a flash drive or CD that is clearly marked. The name of the manuscript file should reference the author. In addition, submit a paper copy. Send by the date of the conference to:
